Mayor Wolfe opened the work session at 6:10 p.m.

Architectural Review – Community Resource Coordinator Gary Michaud explained that a committee drafted architectural guidelines for Main Street. The Committee consisted of three Main Street business owners and one contractor.

Council Member Boulette asked if sandwich board signs would be allowed for each building. It was the consensus that those signs would be allowed.

Steve Baumann stated he appreciated the effort of the committee with the guideline document. Mr. Baumann stated he was concerned with changing history and that he does not agree with a permanent enshrinement. Mr. Baumann stated he felt some comments in the document were pointing a finger at a specific building. He stated that he was not sure in the long view that this would be wise to add an ordinance to maintain a "time". He stated guidelines like these creep into other things i.e. residential districts and etc.

The Council will hold a public hearing on the issue of guidelines for architectural review.

Airport Hangar Request - Steve Osborn – Mr. Osborn stated his goal is to build a hangar to start his A&P business. He plans to hire his son when he leaves the military. The airport board recommended a site at the end of taxiway 3 but Mr. Osborn would rather have the site next to the old terminal building/Wind River Aviation hangar. After discussion the consensus of the council was to honor the airport board decision.
