- a) Personal Privilege – Mayor and Council

Council Member Barton stated that she encourages the public to contact City Hall or their Council Member with questions or comments about the City.

- b) Department Report – Emergency Management/Safety – Dan Shatto

Emergency Management/Safety Officer Dan Shatto informed the Council of the public hearing concerning the three water rights the City is transferring on Wednesday March 10, 2010. Mr. Shatto updated the Council on the emergency plan for Worthen Meadows Reservoir stating he has begun work on the plan and will need to review some items of the plan with the Mayor and Council. Mr. Shatto stated he is working with OSHA to review regulations with some of the City department heads.

- c) Department Report – Underage Drinking – LPD Detective Sgt Fred Cox

Detective Sergeant Fred Cox updated the Council on the problem of underage drinking within the City of Lander. The City of Lander receives grant funds each year to assist with the cost of checking the bars for underage clients, walk throughs, party patrols and educating the businesses to recognize a fake identification. He stated the grant also assists with additional patrol during games at the high school. Sgt. Cox stated in 2009 there were 74 MIP, 106 DUI and 12 citations to adults for furnishing alcohol to a minor.

Sgt. Cox stated already in 2010 the City has issued 23 DUI citations.
