

## Ice Skating Season 2020 Covid 19 Style

Greetings from Parks and Recreation!

WE WILL HAVE ICE SKATING this season, HOWEVER, we are going to have to run things differently this year due to the Covid-19 mandates.

We will not be able to offer concessions or have the building available for use this season. The building doors will be locked. You will need to call 332-4647 to make an appointment or if you need assistance.

Ice skating will be **FREE** of charge. The panels and mats will be down and we will have benches outside for people to use to change their shoes. The restroom doors at the back of the building will be unlocked for use. We can have 200 people at one time in an outdoor setting. Those neck gaters will come in handy to double as your mask as you skate!! The gates will be open for access from the back and front parking lots. **The ice rink will be open Officially Friday, December 18th. Recreation skate hours will be Monday thru Sunday from 12 noon to 5pm. Rec skating evening hours will be Wednesday, Friday, and Saturday nights from 7-9pm.** We will have an employee in the building or on the rink during the official times that the rink is "open" to monitor activity and for safety.

General Rules will apply for this skating season. Hockey only inside the boards, not on the open rink. **Soft pucks must be used.** We will have those for sale for \$5 each. Please call 332-4647 for more information.

We **will not be** able to rent skates due to the contact and sanitizing concerns. We need to be as "contact" free as possible. If you have skates to swap, please contact the park at 332-4647 and we can distribute them to those who need them. The parks office has some skates we will have available as well. If, under dire circumstances, you do not have the ability to get skates, please call the park office at 332-4647 to make arrangements and we will see what we can find for you.

The skating season will end on February 1, 2021. What this means is that the ice will no longer be zambonied and the building will not be staffed to monitor the rink.
