ORDINANCE 1201

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 6-1-1 DEFINITIONS 6-3-3 - NOISY ANIMALS AND 6-4-5 KEEPING LARGE ANIMALS AND FOWL WITHIN THE CITY OF LANDER

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Governing Body of the City of Lander, Fremont County, Wyoming:

SECTION 1: 6-1-1. **Definitions** - The following definitions shall apply to this Title:

- (a) Section 6-1-1(a). "At Large":
- (iii) An animal, for purposes of section 6-1-1 to and including 6-4-4, is defined as fowl and dogs of various breeds.
- (iv) Fowl, for the purpose of Section 6-1-1 to and including section 6-4-5, is defined as ducks, geese, turkeys, pheasants, peacocks, chickens and other domestic or game birds raised and/or maintained in confinement.

SECTION 2: 6-3-3. Noisy Animals

(a) No person shall own or keep any animal which by continual or repeated barking, screeching, yowling, howling, yelping, crowing or cackling disturbs the peace of others.

SECTION 3: 6-4-5 Keeping Large Animals and Fowl -

(g) Fowl must have a permit. Application for the permit can be picked up at City Hall and filed with the City Clerk. The permit will be free of charge. Applications must be submitted prior to obtaining Fowl and renewed by the 1st of July of each year.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law and the ordinances of the City of Lander.
